As per read (1), Govt .of India aims to make all government services digitally accessible to citizens through multiple channels such as web, mobile and common service delivery outlets. Inter operability among various e- Governance systems is an important pre requisite for upgrading the quality and effectiveness of service delivery. For promoting open standards for software inter operability across Govt. departments and agencies, Govt. of India has already notified the ‘policy on open standards for e-Governance ‘and ‘Technical standards on inter operability framework for e-Governance’. Given the enormous advantages in this regard, there is a need to formulate a policy for Govt. Organisations in India to provide open Application Programming Interface (APIs).The Open Application Interface Policy promote software Inter operability for all e-Governance applications & Systems and provide access to data & Services for promoting participation of all stake holders including citizens.

As per read (2), a proposal for formulating and implementing Open API in M G University was submitted by the Administration, IT Cell.

As per read (3), the Honourable Pro-Vice Chancellor has recommended to implement Open API Policy as suggested in the proposal read (2). The Honourable Vice Chancellor, after proper deliberations, has approved the recommendation and authorised Sri.Madhu V T, IT Co-ordinator to implement the same in MG University.

- i)** Formulate Open Application Programming Interface (API) policy for MG University
- ii)** Provide API connectivity to all systems (legacy & new) on the basis of the API policy formulated
- iii)** Authorise Sri.Madhu V T, IT Co-ordinator to implement (i) &(ii) above in University and to implement the same
