ORDER

The President, Bharata Mata College Educational Trust had submitted an application vide paper read as (1) above for starting new self-financing programme, Three Year Unitary LL.B in the Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Choondy, Aluva(Unaided Law College) during the academic year 2022-'23.

The University had constituted Inspection Commission to assess the infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the college vide paper read as (2) above.

Considering the Inspection Report submitted by the Inspection Commission, the Syndicate Sub Committee on Affiliation and Approval of the University vide paper (3) read above recommended that, to approve the report of the inspection commission to start Three Year Unitary LL.B programme with 60 seats in Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Aluva for the academic year 2022-'23 and to seek the approval of the Bar Council of India after receiving NOC from Government of Kerala and after obtaining the approval from the Bar Council of India, to grant provisional affiliation to the Three Year Unitary LL.B programme in Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Aluva with an intake of 60 seats for the academic year 2022-'23.

The Pro Vice-Chancellor in charge of Vice Chancellor, exercising powers under Chapter III, Section 10 (17) of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act, 1985, has approved the above recommendation.

According to the above and as per the provisions contained in the Act and Statutes, for seeking views/NOC of the Government a letter has forwarded to the Government, vide paper (4) read above.

As a reply to the above, the Higher Education (C) Department vide paper (5) read above has informed that, the application for commencing Three Year Unitary LL.B programme with 60 seats in Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Aluva (Unaided Law College affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam) during the academic year 2022-'23 will be considered upon the submission of proposal along with the necessary documents.

Considering all the relevant matters in detail, the Syndicate vide paper (6) read above has resolved to grant provisional affiliation to the Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Choondy, Aluva subject to the approval from the Bar Council of India during the academic year 2022-'23 for the new programme as detailed below:

The provisional affiliation granted is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The provisional affiliation granted is for the academic year 2022-'23 only for seeking views/NOC from the Government of Kerala and approval of the Bar Council of India.
- 2. The starting of the above programme shall be made only after obtaining the approval of the Bar Council of India.
- 3. The admission of the students and commencement of classes for the said programme in the college shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University and Bar Council of India.
- 4. The Educational Agency shall furnish an undertaking in a stamp paper worth Rs 200/- to the effect that it will abide by the rules, regulations and instructions issued by the University, State Govt. and Bar Council of India regarding the admissions to the programme from time to time.
- 5. Further instructions in this regard relating to admission notification, fee structure and other admission rules shall be issued on production of the NOC from Government of Kerala and approval from the Bar Council of India.
- 6. There shall not be any financial commitment to the Govt/University.
- 7. Non-compliance with any of the above mentioned conditions will result in the withdrawal of the provisional affiliation without any notice.
