### <u>ORDER</u>

The Mahatma Gandhi University Under Graduate Programmes (Honours) Regulations, 2024, MGU - UGP (Honours) have been approved, vide paper read as (1) above, for the commencement of Four Year Under Graduate Programmes from the academic year 2024 - 2025 in the affiliated colleges of the university in accordance with the guidelines of UGC and KSHEC.

Among the various committees constituted for the smooth implementation of the Four Year Under Graduate Programmes, the Subcommittee on Rules and Regulations after detailed deliberations, submitted recommendations, vide paper read as (2) above, to amend the MGU - UGP (Honours) Regulations, 2024.

The action taken by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, in exercise of the Powers of Academic Council vested up on him under section 10(17), Chapter III of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985 and consequent issuance of the U.O.No.1933/LEGN/2024/MGU, dated 29.02.2024 and the recommendations submitted by the Subcommittee on Rules and Regulations were placed before the Academic Council for consideration.

The Academic Council of the University at its meeting held on 23.05.2024 , vide paper read as (3) above, resolved to,
