#### Requirements

# l. Computer system:

The computer system used for applying online should have the necessary updated versions and facilities.

#### II. Email ID:

Candidate should possess a **valid** email id. **Email id is also mandatory for applying Private registration 2024.** Candidates should strictly provide their email ids for future correspondence.

#### **III. Mobile Phone Number:**

Candidate should provide **two valid mobile phone numbers and email id**. Give a 10 digit number of you and your parent's mobile phone. The number should not be prefixed with country code or Zero. The mobile phone number and mail id provided by you facilitates the office to communicate any special information through messages or by calling.

# IV. Photograph:

For applying online, the candidates must have scanned /digital image of his/her photograph in *jpeg* format. The specification of photograph image should be as follows:

- 1. Size of the photograph should be passport size taken within 6 months
- 2. Photograph must be in colour with a light colour background, white is preferable
- 3. Face of the candidate should be **straight and clear**
- 4. Photos taken wearing dark glasses will be rejected
- 5. Scanned image file should be in jpg (jpeg) format only
- 6. Dimensions of the photograph should be 150 pixels width and 200 pixels height
- 7. Size of the image file should be between 15 kb and 50 kb.
- 8. If the face in the photograph is unclear, your application is liable to be rejected.

#### II. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### a. Single Registration under Semester Scheme

Candidates will be permitted to appear for M.A./M.Com./ M.Sc. (Mathematics) Degree examinations as private candidates without undergoing the regular course of study by attending a college affiliated to the University provided the subjects offered for the examination do not involve practical. As per U.O.6374/AIII/3/2011/Acad,Dated 25/11/2011,students are permitted to write the PG examinations in Malayalam (Except in Languages).

#### **EXAMINATION: -**

End Semester Examinations: The examination shall normally be conducted at the end of each semester for college going students. For private examination for both semesters shall be conducted at the end of the academic year.

#### **b.** Selection of Subjects

Candidates shall be permitted to choose only those group/optionals/electives/streams which are offered for the concerned examinations in any of the affiliated colleges under the University.

#### c. Prohibition of Simultaneous Study

Candidates who have been given private registration for any Programme of study as per these regulations shall be allowed to undergo any other Programme of study either by Private Registration or as a regular student before they take the examination for which Private Registration is granted subject to the conditions mentioned in U.O.No.1368/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dated.06.02.2023 only. As per this order candidates who have completed but not passed M.Com course of this University are permitted to join for

B.Com Additional Elective (Co-Operation) based on their degree without cancelling their PG registration or availing discontinuity certificate. And as per U.O.No.8275/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dtd. 31.07.2023, the candidates who have not passed their previous course can join for a new course and candidates who are undergoing a course and have got attendance to register for the final semester examination are permitted to join for a new course afresh, without cancelling their PG registration or availing discontinuity certificate.

Candidates who have been given private registration for any course of study as per these regulations, shall not be allowed to undergo any other course either by Private Registration or as a regular student before they take the examinations for which Private Registration is granted (except for the conditions stipulated in U.O.No.1368/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dated.06.02.2023,

U.O.No.6569/ACA3/2023/MGU,Dated.12/06/2023 & U.O.No.8275/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dtd. 31.07.2023 ) a)As per U.O.No.1368/ACA3/2023/MGU, Dated:06/02/202, candidates of Mahatma Gandhi university who have completed but not passed M. Com course are permitted to take Additional Elective on the basis of their B.Com degree without availing cancellation of its registration or discontinuity certificate. b) As per U.O.No.6569/ACA3/2023/MGU,Dated.12/06/2023 , candidates who can opt for M.Com Course based on one qualifying degree even if whose additional B.Com course, if chosen, has not been completed c) As per U.O.No.8275/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dtd. 31.07.2023, those candidates who have not passed their previous course can join for a new course and those candidates who are undergoing a course and have got attendance to register for the final year semester are permitted to join for a new course afresh, without cancelling their PG registration or availing discontinuity certificate.

#### d. Scheme and Syllabus

The new scheme and syllabi in the Semester Pattern (MGU-PG-CSS 2019), is being followed for the candidates under private registration scheme from 2019 admission onwards.

#### e. Private Registration Number

The Private Registration Number given to the candidates shall be quoted for future correspondence with regard to his/her private registration. The number can be seen in the Private Registration Seals of the University affixed on the reverse side of the Qualifying Certificate and Transfer Certificate.

#### f. Course Discontinuation and Re-Admission

Candidates who have registered for PG course under private registration scheme and those who have registered/appeared for the first year (I & II Semester) examination are permitted to discontinue their course for joining another course. The application for Course discontinuation should be accompanied by the MGU E-Receipt for the prescribed fee, Transfer Certificate, Qualifying Certificate and a Non-Malpractice Certificate from the Principal/Chief Superintendent Concerned. Candidates who have thus discontinued his private study and registered for the examination of a new Course shall not be re-admitted in the same academic year under any circumstances. Discontinued candidates will have to obtain readmission order from this University before rejoining. The candidate discontinued themselves without obtaining prior sanction from this University and join another course shall not be given re-admission. They can continue their study by taking fresh registration. Candidates who have registered as private students and appeared/registered for first and second semester examination but not registered for the third/fourth semester examination should obtain re-admission order from the Registrar of this University for continuing their studies.

#### g. Matriculation

Candidates, who have been matriculated under this University at present, need not apply for further matriculation. Candidates who have not matriculated in this University shall apply for such registration in the prescribed form paying the prescribed fee. In such cases, both the matriculation fee and private registration fee should be remitted through Integrated Online Payment System. Candidates who have already obtained migration certificate from this University and wish to apply for private registration should re-matriculate in this University by paying the prescribed fee and submitting the application for matriculation along with the Migration certificate.

#### h. Recognition

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall be required to apply for recognition of the qualifying examination passed by them, in the prescribed form paying the prescribed fee. Such candidates applying for recognition of the qualifying examination shall submit along with their application, the qualifying certificate, migration certificate and eligibility certificate. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Universities within the State of Kerala are exempted from individual recognition if the examination passed by them is recognised by this University. However, they have to produce a No Objection Certificate / Migration Certificate from the Universities concerned.

#### i. Eligibility Certificate (through online only)

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state <u>should</u> <u>apply online</u> for <u>Eligibility Certificate</u> from the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam-686560. (For more information please visit http://certificates.mgu.ac.in Only after getting the eligibility certificate they shall acquire the eligibility to apply for private registration.

#### j. Cancellation of Private Registration/Examination

Candidates can cancel their P.G. registration in this University to join other courses, or to join afresh a P.G. Course in the same/different subject either by regular or by private study. Those who cancel and join afresh a P.G. Course in the same subject shall not be considered for ranking.

# k. Notional Registration to private Candidates - Notional registration common to all private candidates as per the following conditions.

- i. The candidate should apply for notional registration within two months after the completion of the examination.
- ii. Notional Registration shall be limited to the II, III and IV Semester examinations.
- iii. Candidates should fulfill all the requirements (except attendance) for notional registration as in the case of regular students.
- iv. Amount of fee should be thrice the amount of normal examination fee.
- v. Notional registration shall be allowed only for a single chance during the entire course; i.e. no consecutive notional registration shall be granted to a single Semester.
- vi. Notional registration shall not be allowed to candidates who are punished for malpractice to appear

for the University examination till a final decision is taken in their malpractices cases. (Please refer U. 0. No.614/AIII/3/2010/Acad. dt.08.02.11 issued by Academic A-III section, Mahatma Gandhi University).

#### Note:

- i. Persons who are permanent residence of or domiciled within Kerala State are eligible to apply for Private Registration.
- ii. Candidates debarred by the University from appearing for any of the University examinations or candidates undergoing disciplinary proceedings initiated by the Principal of the College in which they study shall not be eligible to apply for Private Registration before the period of debar is over.
- iii. M.Phil/ Ph.D Degree holders of this university are allowed to take additional PG Degree provided the marks secured by such candidates in the additional PG Degree examination will not be considered for Ranking.(U.O NO. AcAIII/1/1185/97 dated 14/09/1998)
- iv. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from Universities/Boards outside the state should obtain the Eligibility Certificate from the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University before applying for private registration.
- v. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination through liberalized scheme of any University/Board are not eligible to apply for PG Private Registration.
- vi. Candidates who have passed Model II (Vocational) Degree Courses are eligible to apply for private registration subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.

#### A. REGISTRATION FOR PG COURSES TO CANDIDATES WHO HAVE HIGHER QUALIFICATIONS

As per U.O. No.1131/AIII/1/1927/2015 dated 24/02/2016 of Academic Section Candidates who wish to register for any PG examination of Mahatma Gandhi University under private/regular stream can be allowed to do so even though he/she passed any examination from other universities or this university which is considered to be higher than for which he/she desires to register for ,with the following conditions.

- 1. Candidates who have been awarded a PG Degree by Mahatma Gandhi University in a particular subject shall not be permitted to register for the same subject.
- 2. The Marks/Grade Scored by such candidates will not be considered for determining up to the 10<sup>th</sup> Position.
- 3. He/ She should have fulfilled the eligibility conditions for admission to courses for which he/she wishes to register for the examinations.

#### V. SCHEME & SYLLABI AT A GLANCE

In lieu of the course 'Project / Dissertation' offered in the IV Semester for the Regular Mode, a separate course/programme shall be included for students undergoing Private Study.

#### **END-SEMESTER EXAMINATION**

The examination shall normally be conducted at the end of each semester for college going students. For private examination for both semesters shall be conducted at the end of the academic year.

#### **INTERNAL EVALUATION**

Private students will have to answer an additional question paper with objective type questions as part of internal evaluation along with the external examinations within the prescribed time.

#### **ELECTIVE COURSES AND GROUPS**

The number of Elective Groups for PG PRIVATE COURSES (EXCEPT M.Com) shall be limited in Private Mode. Only one Elective Group comprising of three courses each for a programme is permitted and these elective courses shall be included either in IV Semester or be distributed among III and IV Semesters.

A student who has registered for the programme shall <u>complete the programme within a period of four years</u> from the date of commencement of the programme.

Students are eligible to pursue studies for **Additional Post Graduate Degree**. They shall be eligible for award of degree only after successful completion of two years (four semesters of study) either as college going student or through private study.

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Candidates for admission to the first semester of the PG programme through CSS shall be required to have passed an appropriate Degree Examination of Mahatma Gandhi University as specified or any other examination of any recognized University or authority accepted by the Academic council of Mahatma Gandhi University as eligible thereto.

Students admitted under this programme are governed by the Regulations in force.
