- 10. The Core Course/Second Language/Additional Language (Common Course)/Complementary Course chosen, will in no case be permitted to get changed before the completion of the course.
- 11. Candidates are permitted to rectify mistakes, if any, occurred during the online submission process. The request for such corrections along with a correction fee MGU E-Receipt for Rs.615/- shall be submitted to the Private Registration sections within 15 days from the last date for receipt of filled in application in the University office as per the notification.
- 12. **B.Com** Candidates are permitted to change their **Optional** up to one month before the commencement of III Semester examination, by remitting the prescribed fee. Similarly **B.A./B.Com** candidates are also permitted to change their **Open Course** up to one month before the commencement of IV/V Semester examination by remitting the prescribed Fee (Refer Rules & Regulations below).
- 13. Candidates applying for private registration for UG Programmes under CBCS shall study the curriculum of CBCS (Model-I) and the same is available in the Rules & Regulations given under Appendix II.

- 14. Fee once remitted will not be refunded. Fees remitted before the last date prescribed alone will not be considered as a claim for acceptance of application.
- 15. Candidates who obtain Readmission for a course should register for the next immediate regular examination of the year to which the candidate was admitted. He/She cannot register for a supplementary examination in his/her first attempt.

- 16. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Mahatma Gandhi University alone will be allowed to register under private registration scheme for Non Full Courses listed at the notification. beginning this (Please Refer Order No. **6962/ACA3/2023/m.g.u.**; Dated:22.06.2023 (Available at www.mgu.ac.in > Admission 2024 > UG Private Registration > UG PR Order 2024-25)
- 17. Candidates applying for private registration should give only their residential address in the column provided for the purpose in the application form and also in the self-addressed cover. Communications in the address of the parallel institutions in which they are studying will not be entertained.
- 18. Interim request to return the documents submitted will be considered only if the application is submitted by registered post. Rs. 615/- will be charged against retrieval of documents prior Registration.
- 19. The Centre of Examination and subject selected by the candidate and type of registration should be superscribed both on the private registration application and on the envelope.
- 20. Transfer Certificate and the qualifying certificates will be returned to the applicant after private registration is granted.
- 21. Candidates should note down the details of the fee remitted for further reference. They are also advised to take the attested photocopies of the original documents submitted by them including a copy of the filled up application.
- 22. Candidates applying for Private Registration should ensure that their name entered in the Transfer Certificate/Pass Certificate/Application etc. is the same as entered in their SSLC Book/10<sup>th</sup> Certificate. If any corrections in this regard should be made before submitting the application.
- 23. All candidates (except UG Full Course candidates) should affix passport size photograph duly attested on the Private Registration order form.

# REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING ONLINE FOR UG PRIVATE REGISTRATION 2024 (FULL COURSE ONLY) IN MAHATMA GANDHI UNIVERSITY

# **Requirements:**

## 1. Computer system:

The computer system used for applying online should have the necessary updated versions and facilities.

### 2. Email ID:

Candidate should possess a valid email id. <u>Email id is mandatory for applying Private</u> <u>Registration 2024.</u> Candidates should strictly provide their <u>email ids</u> for future correspondence.

### 3. Mobile Phone Number:

Candidate should provide two valid mobile phone numbers and their email ids. Give a 10 digit number of you and your parent's mobile phone. The number should not be prefixed with country code or Zero. The mobile phone number and mail ids provided by you facilitates the office to communicate any special information through messages or by calling.

### 4. Photograph:

For applying online, the candidates must have scanned/digital image of his/her photograph in *jpeg* format. The specification of photograph image should be as follows:

- a) Size of the photograph should be passport size taken within 6 months
- b) Photograph must be in color with a light color background, white is preferable
- c) Face of the candidate should be straight and clear
- d) Photo wearing dark glasses will be rejected
- e) Scanned image file should be in jpg (jpeg) format only
- f) Dimensions of the photograph should be 150 pixels width and 200 pixels height
- g) Size of the image file should be between 15 kb and 50 kb.
- h) If the face in the photograph is unclear, your application is liable to be rejected.

# MAHATMA GANDHI UNIVERSITY GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS REGARDING PRIVATE REGISTRATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

- 1. Single Registration under the CBCS (Semester Scheme)
- a. Candidates will be allowed to appear for B.A./B.Com. Degree Examination under the CBCS (Semester scheme) implemented vide സ.ഉ.നം. 6347/എൽ/അക്കാദമിക്/2017, തീയതി: 28.10.2017, as Private candidates without undergoing the regular course of study by attending a college affiliated to the University, provided that the subjects offered for the examination do not involve practicals. (As per U.O.12579/AIII/3/2022/MGU,Dated 12/12/2022,students are permitted to write the UG examinations in Malayalam (Except in Languages).
- b. There shall be single registration for a Programme. Candidates who have appeared for the examination after being registered as Private Candidates but have failed in the examination may appear for the next session of examination without registering again as Private Candidates. Such candidates shall, however, be required to register to the concerned examination on payment of the prescribed fee.

### **UG FULL COURSE**

For UG private full courses, semester wise examination along with Regular College students will be conducted from second semester onwards. At the end of second semester, separate examination will be conducted for the first semester UG private full course students alone, i.e.

- The 1<sup>st</sup> &2<sup>nd</sup> Semester examination of UG private full course will be conducted along with the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examinations of regular college students and
- The 3, 4, 5 & 6 Semester examinations of UG private full courses will be conducted along with the Regular College Students.

### **UG NON FULL COURSES**

For the UG private Non full courses, Examinations of both semesters will be conducted annually at the end of the Academic year. i.e. the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examination at the end of second semester. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester at the end of fourth semester and 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semester examinations at the end of sixth semester.

# 2. Selection of Subjects

- a. Candidates shall be permitted to choose only those Core courses, Complementary courses, Common courses and Optional course under the Core Course of the Undergraduate Programme as under III 'Courses offered'.
- b. Candidates shall be permitted to choose only those Complementary courses which are permitted for the Core course chosen by them as under III 'Courses offered'.

# 3. Correction/Change of Optional Course/Common Course-II (Additional Language)/Open Course:

Candidates are permitted to correct/change their optional Course/Common course, Additional Language/Open Course/II Language already chosen.

## 3.1 B.Com candidates are permitted to *correct/change their optional* as follows:

- a. Upto one month prior to the I Semester/II Semester exam: by remitting Rs. 1225/-
- b. Upto one month prior to the III Semester exam: by remitting Rs. 2440/-

### 3.2 B.A./B.Com Candidates are permitted to correct/change their open courses as follows:

- a. Upto one month prior to the IV Semester exam: by remitting Rs. 1225/-
- b. Upto one month prior to the V Semester exam: by remitting Rs. 2440/-

# 3.3 B.A./B.Com Candidates are permitted to <u>correct/change their Second Language</u> (<u>Common Course –II)</u> as follows:

- a) Upto one month before first examination (either Ist or IInd Semester): by remitting Rs. 1225/-
  - 4. Registration

- a. All the students who satisfy the minimum eligibility conditions can register through Private Registration, in different programmes.
- b. A student who register for the programme shall complete the programme within 6 years from the year of registration.
- c. Those students who could not complete the UG courses in annual pattern successfully can cancel their earlier registration and can register afresh for Choice Based Credit System UG programme in the same discipline or a different one.

### 5. Change from Regular study to Private study

A student registered under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS-2017) -UG-Regular pattern can change over to the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS-2017) -UG-Private mode in the same core programme, if that programme is offered under the CBCS-UG- Private Mode and continue his studies from where he had stopped subject to the conditions as per U.O.No..6962/ACA3/2023/m.g.u..Dated:22/06/2023 (Available at www.mgu.ac.in > Admission 2024> UG Private Registration> UG PR Order 2024-25).

As per CBCS-2017 regulation, **B.Com Model-II** - Regular to Private stream change is **not permitted**. Please refer Order No. 6962/ACA3/2023/m.g.u.; Dated:22/06/2023 (Available at www.mgu.ac.in > Admission 2024> UG Private Registration> UG PR Order 2024-25).

Students discontinued from previous regulations CBCSS 2013, can pursue their studies in the Mahatma Gandhi University "Regulations for Under Graduate Programmes under Choice Based Credit System 2017" after obtaining re-admission. These students have to complete the programme as per the Mahatma Gandhi University "Regulations for Under Graduate Programmes under Choice Based Credit System 2017"

### 6. Prohibition of simultaneous study

Candidates who have been given private registration for any Programme of study as per these regulations shall be allowed to undergo any other Programme of study either by Private Registration or as a regular student before they take the examination for which Private Registration is granted subject to the conditions mentioned in U.O.No.1368/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dated.06.02.2023 only. As per this order candidates who have completed but not passed M.Com course of this University are permitted to join for B.Com Additional Electives (Co-Operation/Taxation/Travel& Tourism) based on their degree without

cancelling their PG registration or availing discontinuity certificate. And as per U.O.No.8275/ACAIII/2023/MGU,Dtd. 31.07.2023, the candidates who have not passed their previous course can join for a new course and candidates who are undergoing a course and have got attendance to register for the final semester examination are permitted to join for a new course afresh, without cancelling their PG registration or availing discontinuity certificate.

# 7. Equivalency

The general rules and regulations relating to minimum qualification for admission, scheme of examination, Pass minimum and classification of successful candidates for the B.A./B.Com. Degree Examinations shall be applicable to the Private candidates also.

# 8. Private Registration Number

Private registration number allotted to the candidate shall be quoted for future correspondence with regard to his/her Private registration. The number can be seen in the Private registration seal of the University affixed on the reverse side of the Qualifying certificate and Transfer Certificate.

# 9. UG Programme discontinuation and re-admission

Candidates who have registered for UG Programme under private registration scheme and those who have registered/ appeared for the I/II/III/IV/V<sup>th</sup> Semester are permitted to discontinue their Programme/Course for joining another U.G.C. sponsored/Professional/Vocational course. The application for UG Programme discontinuation should be accompanied by the E-Receipt for the prescribed fee, Qualifying Certificate, Transfer Certificate and a Non-malpractice certificate from the Principal concerned i.e. the principal of the college where the candidate has appeared for the examination.

In the event of readmitting the Candidates who have thus discontinued the private study and registered for pursuing another UG Programme, shall not be re-admitted in the same academic year under any circumstances. Discontinued candidates will have to obtain a Re-admission Order from the University before rejoining.

Candidates who have registered as Private students and not registered for the III/IV Semester examination and also not registered for the V/VI<sup>th</sup> Semester examination, should obtain a Readmission Order from the University for continuing their studies.(U.O No 5658/Ac.AIII/(SDE/PRI/1/01/2014)/Pvt.Regn./2014 dated 11/11/2014).

### 10. Matriculation

Candidates, who have been matriculated under the University at present, need not apply for matriculation again. Candidates who are in need of matriculation in the University shall apply for such registration by paying the prescribed fee. In such cases, both the matriculation fee and private registration fee should be remitted through the 'Payment Integrated Online Application System'.

Candidates who have obtained migration certificate from this University and now wish to apply for

Private Registration should re-matriculate in this University by paying the prescribed fee and should furnish the details concerned in the application form and submitting it along with the Migration Certificate.

# 11. Recognition of Examination

Candidates who have passed the Qualifying examination of the Universities/Boards outside the state shall be required to apply for recognition of the qualifying examination passed by them, by duly filled in application after paying the prescribed fee. Candidates who have qualified under CBSE and ICSE need not apply for recognition.

Candidates applying for recognition of the qualifying examination shall submit, along with their application, the Qualifying Certificate, Mark list, Migration Certificate, Eligibility Certificate and Transfer Certificate.

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any of the Universities within the State of Kerala are exempted from individual recognition if the examination passed by them is recognized by the University. However, they shall be required to produce a No Objection Certificate/Migration Certificate as the case may be. The candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary School Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary School Examination/Diploma in Commercial Practice of Kerala State are exempted from producing Migration Certificate and also individual recognition.

# 12. Eligibility Certificate (Online)

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state should obtain **Eligibility Certificate from the Registrar**, **Mahatma Gandhi University**, **Kottayam**. (Eligibility Certificate can be obtained through online application only) <u>Such candidates attain eligibility for private registration only after producing the Eligibility Certificate issued by the <u>Registrar of the University</u>, along with other documents required.</u>

B.Com degree holders (Model I & II) of this University will be permitted to appear for the 10 common course syllabus (6 English core & 4 second language / Additional Language courses) prescribed for B.A./B.Sc UG Programme in one academic year through private registration so as to enable them to pursue higher studies in the language concerned subject to the condition that no consolidation will be allowed with his/her previous B.Com.

As per U.O.No.5005/AIII/1/487/2014/Acad;dated:25/08/2015 Pre-CBCSS B.Com Graduates are also eligible to register for Common Course I/Common Course II or both.

- 3. B.Com Degree/Provisional Certificate
- 4. Transfer Certificate in Original

## **QUALIFICATION / ELIGIBILITY**

Persons who are permanent residents of/or domiciled in Kerala and who have passed the Predegree examination of this University/Higher Secondary examination (Kerala Govt.) or any other examination recognized by this University as equivalent thereto are eligible to apply for Degree (Full course) private registration.

# **Eligibility for Private Registration UG Programmes**

Academic eligibility should be satisfied as on the date of notification.

Eligibility for Admission- No minimum mark is prescribed to apply for UG Programme under Private Registration.

Those who have obtained the diploma in Commercial practice (Govt. of Kerala) will be permitted to register for B.Com (Full course).

Non Full Courses - Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Mahatma Gandhi University alone will be allowed to register for Non Full Courses under private registration scheme, listed in the notification.

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities/Boards Outside the State should obtain the Eligibility certificate (Online) from the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University before applying for private registration. For online eligibility certificate please visit https://certificates.mgu.ac.in.

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations through Open Liberalized Scheme of any University/Board are not eligible to apply for private registration.

Candidates debarred by the University from appearing for any of the University examinations or candidates under disciplinary action by the Principal of the college in which they studied shall not be eligible to apply for private registration as a private candidate, before such actions or the periods of debar are over.

Candidates who have passed <u>Afzal- ul -Ulama Preliminary examination</u> of Calicut University are eligible to apply for the Degree Programmes under Private Registration as per U.O.No.3818/AcD/3/7786/CR/2016;dated:04/07/2017.

The interval between the date of passing the qualifying examination and the date of examination for which registration is applied for shall not be less than the normal period prescribed for the course, ie., candidates who have passed the qualifying examination on or before the last March session only are eligible to apply for Private Registration in the current year. However, candidates who have passed the 'SAY' examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or other compartmental examinations before the date of closing of admission to regular degree courses are eligible to apply for Degree (Full course) registration.

#### **UG - FULL COURSE**

From 2019-20 Admission onwards, for UG private full courses, semester wise examination along with Regular College students will be conducted from second semester onwards. At the end of second semester, separate examination will be conducted for the first semester U.G. private full course students alone, i.e.

## From 2019-20 Admission onwards,

- The 1<sup>st</sup> &2<sup>nd</sup> Semester examination of UG private full course will be conducted along with the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examinations of regular college students and
- The 3, 4, 5 & 6 Semester examinations of UG private full courses will be conducted along with the Regular College Students.

### **UG - NON FULL COURSES**

For the UG private Non full courses, Examinations of both semesters will be conducted annually at the end of the academic year. i.e. the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examination at the end of second semester. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester at the end of fourth semester and 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semester examinations at the end of sixth semester.

### **Internal Marks and Minimum for pass**

Internal evaluations will be made on the basis of a Test of 15 minutes duration with 20 multiple choice questions of one mark each. The examinations will be conducted just before the beginning of each external examination of the respective course without affecting the duration of the external examination. There is no minimum mark for internal examination. For external examination, the minimum mark is 30% and for a pass the minimum mark is 35% for both internal and external.

# **General Essay**

In lieu of the course 'Project' for the regular mode, an exam on 'General Essay' will be conducted based on all compulsory Core Courses of Final Semester. Candidates will be asked to answer a prescribed number of questions out of a set of choices. Internal Examination for 'General Essay' will be conducted from 20 multiple choice questions of 1mark each covering all the compulsory Core Courses of the VI Semester.

For the <u>Registration of Non-Full courses such as Additional degree/Optional</u> <u>change/Common courses/Stream change etc.</u>, University Orders issued from time to time will be applicable.

#### **CENTRES OF EXAMINATION**

Candidate can opt any one of the affiliated Colleges/Centers of this university mentioned in the list available in the online application as the Centre of the Examination; but male students should not opt for women's colleges and candidates are permitted to change their centre of examination already chosen. Application for such changes along with the Correction Fee E-Receipt for Rs. 615/shall be submitted to the Private Registration Sections within **15 days** from the last date for receipt of filled in applications in the University Office as per the Notification. **The University reserves the right to change the Centre of Exam selected by the candidate, due to practical reasons.** 

### **MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS**

- Candidates applying for private registration cum examination can collect the Hall ticket and time table from the concerned Centre of Examination three days prior to the date of commencement of examination. No separate intimation will be sent to the candidates.
- Candidates applying for private registration should give only their residential address in the column provided for the purpose in the application form and also on the self addressed stamped envelope.
- Communications in the address of the private institution in which they are studying will not be entertained.
- Interim requests to return the documents submitted along with the application for Private registration, will be attended only if the application is sent by registered post.
- Candidates should note down the details of the fee remitted for further reference.
- They are also advised to keep attested photocopies of the original documents along with hard copies of duly filled/downloaded online application submitted by them.
- Proper care should be taken in applying online/filling the application forms. All details called for therein should be furnished.
